Basic furniture, equipment and services included in the flat-rate rental fee for Guest Events

## Hub 27 Level Alpha rooms α5-α8:

- seating in theatre style
- stage (3x10x0.5 m)
- 1 digital lectern<sup>1</sup> with 2 microphones<sup>2</sup>
- chairman's table with 4 chairs and 2 microphones<sup>2</sup>
- 1 PC audio port on lectern
- 2 microphone ports (handheld or clipped microphones)
- 4 floor standing microphones
- PA system
- 16:9 images projected onto 5 screens (650x370 cm)
- 5 projectors, rigged, 12.000 ANSI lumens
- connecting leads to projector, on lectern, HDMI/DVI port<sup>3</sup>
- 2 preview monitors (22") on chairman's table
- entrance doors (wall partitioning modules) with molton suspended
- wastepaper basket
- air conditioning
- artificial room lighting, illuminated lectern and chairman's table
- basic cleaning service (once per event day)
- wall-to-wall carpeting<sup>4</sup>



Chairs in rows are connected and non-moveable.

Please note that any changes regarding room usage must be specified in advance and are subject to feasibility.

For fire safety reasons objects can only be placed in designated grid areas.

Only Messe Berlin staff or their designated service providers are allowed to operate the technical equipment from Messe Berlin.

Personnel costs for construction and dismantling of the listed furniture and equipment items are included in the rental fee.

Staff employed to operate the technical equipment during the event, as well as changes to the standard set-up, are subject to additional fees.
